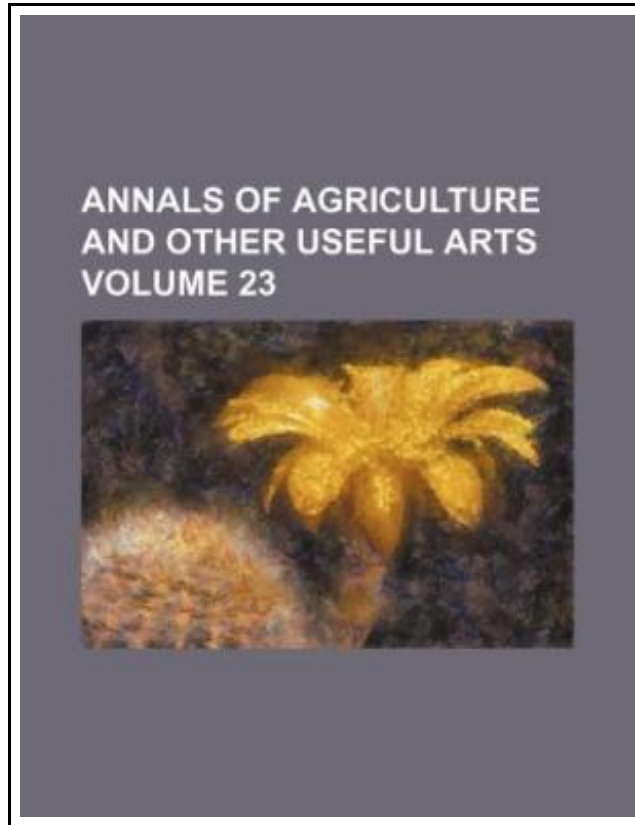

I enclose a copy of correspondence, with Mr. Fitzgerald, Assistant Surgeon, and Major Burr, regarding a desire expressed by the Rajah of Chintipilly for the inspection of the Honourable the President in Council, which I hope he will support, by acquainting the Rajah how agreeable it would be to the Court of Directors and himself. Assure the Honourable the President in Council at the same time, that my garden affords a complete and perfect establishment, from whence the public may derive every assistance in all the branches of the silk manufacture, while I remain in India.
