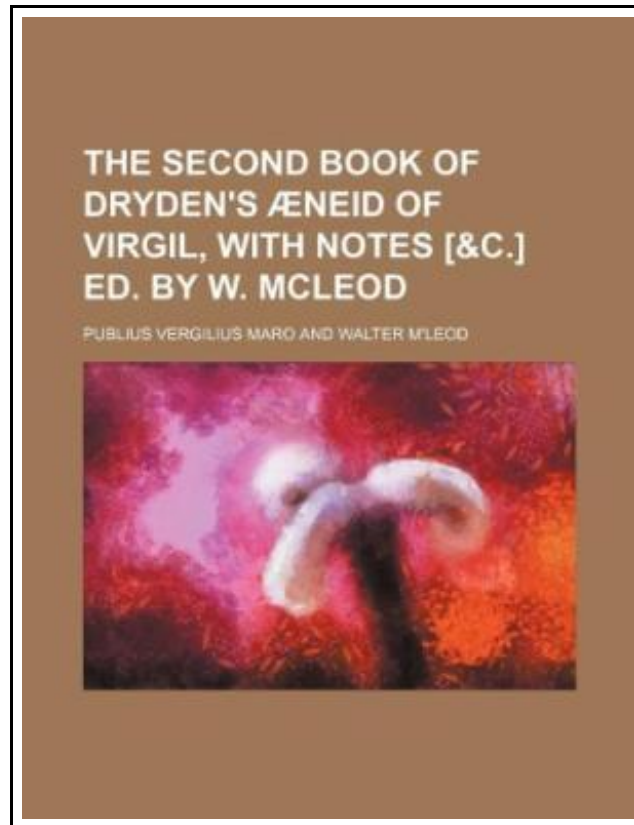

The order is: Thou, wandering long, shalt erect 3 4 whichat last. Line 394.--Stat-es of the gods = l he Penates. (See note on line 703.) Line 395.--Ancient Vesta = the statue of Vesta. Vesta was a deity who presided over public and private happiness. The symbol of the goddess was fire, which was continually kept burning in her temple,...
