The general form of a base for an entire lower denture is exhibited in Fig. 75. The internal border of the plate should usually be doubled, - either by turning the edge over in swaging. or by soldering on a narrow strip of plate or half-round wire. A more perfect adaptation of the plate to the ridge may be obtained by the use of a double instead of a single...
